Dr. Grimley is responsible for the professional nursing practice and care delivery across UCLA Health. Under her leadership, a Safer U was established to improve the safety and well-being of staff, patients and families. She also led the development of a comprehensive workforce strategy that has rusted in nursing engagement and excellence scores exceeding the national benchmarks in at east six of seven categories across the system. Dr. Grimley is also credited with repurposing a program called, Reigniting the Spirit of Caring – a relationship-based care initiative designed to strengthen nursing and health care worker support into an intentional self-care retreat for nurses.
